Program Objectives

01 to train professionals with sufficient skills to undertake management, advisory and directorship roles in the private and public sector, in insurance, banking and stock market companies, and in directorship and managerial roles related to business or the coordination of resources.

02 to enable provision of professional specialized services in handling and interpreting accounting and financial systems; in managing operations related to financial companies and markets; and in management accounting.

03 to endorse skills that enable students to identify and anticipate market and sector opportunities, allocate resources, manage information, select and train personnel, and make the necessary decisions to achieve the goals of the company or institution in which they are employed.

Duration

The program runs five days per week, Sunday to Thursday-Morning or Evening sessions for eight (8) theoretical semesters (16 weeks each), and three (3) summer semesters (8 weeks each), which involves presenting the project report of supervised internship.

Admission Requirements

Applications are welcomed from bank and non-bank employees meeting the following criteria:

01 Students who have completed the Diploma in Banking or Diploma in Islamic Banking may get credit transfer of common subjects with minimum score of 70%

02 Admission is granted according to the general policy of the Institute and the directives of the Board of Directors

03 The applicant should hold a High School Certificate, or its equivalent, with minimum score of 60%

04 The applicant must have a valid English language TOEFL score of 173 (CBT) or 61 (iBT) or academic IELTS Academic 5.0 overall or another standardized, internationally recognized test that is approved by the Commission for Academic Accreditation (CAA)

05 EIBFS offers IELTS coaching classes to students who have not met the above requirement. Students may simultaneously take partial classes in the first year of the Bachelor program

06 The applicant must pass a personal interview at EIBFS
