The Diploma in Banking program is the first ever program in the UAE to focus on helping aspiring and existing bankers to improve their knowledge of banking operations and enhance their qualifications. With many diploma graduates employed in the banking sector already, this program continues to be at the forefront of professional education and development in the banking sector.

Program Objectives

01 to provide fundamental knowledge and understanding of Economics, Banking concepts, Accounting, Finance and Information Technology

02 to introduce students to the various techniques used in the banking and financial industry

03 to strengthen students' ability to identify problems, analyze situations and apply laws in the banking and finance environment

04 to integrate knowledge, interact with professional colleagues and customers for handling Banking products and services

Duration

The program comprises of 60 credit hours and runs five days a week, Sunday to Thursday, morning and evening sessions, for a duration of two years.

Admission Requirements

Applications are welcomed from bank and non-bank employees meeting the following criteria:

01 Admission is granted according to the general policy of the Institute and directives of the Board of Directors.

02 EIBFS welcomes applications from all residents in the UAE though admission preference is given to UAE Nationals.

03 The applicant should hold a High School Certificate with a minimum score of 60%.

04 The applicant must have a valid English language TOEFL score of 173 (CBT) or 61 (iBT) or academic IELTS 5.0 overall or another standardized, internationally recognized test which is approved by the Commission for Academic Accreditation (CAA).

05 EIBFS offers IELTS coaching classes to students who have not met the above requirements and will be allowed to take partial classes in the first year of the Diploma.

06 The applicant must pass a personal interview at the Institute
